

**BUKIT BATOK CITIZENS' CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE**  
**DR ONG CHIT CHUNG STUDY AWARD 2022**

1. **Purpose:** Dr Ong Chit Chung Study Award encourages students from lower income households to excel in their studies. The Study Award is set up under the Bukit Batok CCC Community Development and Welfare Fund.
2. **Closing Date:**  
**12 December 2021** (*For all applicants except GCE N(A)/N(T)-LEVEL applicants*)  
**28 December 2021** (*For GCE N(A)/N(T)-LEVEL applicants only*)
3. **Eligibility:**
  - a) **Registered NRIC residential address** to be of Blocks 101 to 194, 194A to 194B, 201 to 230, 210A, 230A, 292A to 292C, 293A to 293D, 296A to 296C, 297 to 299, 620 to 644 in the Bukit Batok Division;
  - b) Singapore Citizens or children / adopted children of Singapore Citizen;
  - c) Primary 2 to Primary 6 and Secondary 1 to Secondary 5, Pre-U or Junior College levels in Singapore for the year 2022;
  - d) Achieve a class attendance level of **at least 80%** in 2021 (**Only applicable for Pri 2 – Pri 5 applicants**);
  - e) Achieved **at least 50%** in overall results for the final examinations (**Only applicable for Pri 6 – JC/Pre-U applicants**);
  - f) Total household income not exceeding \$3,750 per month or \$1,250 per capita (**excluding grandparents**) of family's monthly income; and
  - g) Not be a recipient of Edusave Awards (Scholarship, EMB, GPA, EAGLES, ECHA, ESA) and CDC-CCC Education Merit Award.
4. **Method of application:** Applications must be made on prescribed forms and submitted with the endorsement of the school official to the Bukit Batok Community Club together with a copy of each of the following documents:
  - a) **Applicant's birth certificate, Singapore Citizenship Certificates or proof of adoption.**
  - b) **Legal guardianship documents (if applicable)**
  - c) **One of the parents'/guardians' Singapore Citizenship Certificates or Singapore Pink Identity Cards**
  - d) **Detailed results of ALL Examinations for 2021**
  - e) **Divorce certificate and/or death certificate (if applicable)**
5. **Value of awards for students studying in 2022:**

(a) Primary 2	\$200.00
(b) Primary 3 to 6	\$250.00
(b) Secondary 1 to 5	\$400.00
(c) Junior College / Pre-U	\$450.00
6. **Terms of the awards:**
  - (a) The awards are for one year only and recipients may re-apply in subsequent years.
  - (b) The decision of the Selection Committee is final.
